



2022 HAMBURG EUROPEAN OPEN – Accreditation (Terms and Conditions)

Any violation of the following terms and conditions of accreditation may lead to the immediate withdrawal of the current accreditation and at the discretion of the organizer also lead to denial of accreditation for the future:

- 1.) Any accreditation remains the property of the organizer, who reserves the right not to exhibit or withdraw at any time, also without giving reasons.
- 2.) The accreditation is not transferable.
- 3.) The accreditation must be visible at all times in the approved areas. The photo must be visible and the accreditation can be closely monitored at any time from the tournament organizer and their representatives.
- 4.) The accreditation allows access only to the areas listed there. Access to other non-public areas is not allowed.
- 5.) The making of copies and / or the production of photos (or the like) is not permitted.
- 6.) The instructions of the tournament organizers and their representatives is necessarily to be followed.
- 7.) In non-public areas is unauthorized photographing (recording of videos or the like) not allowed. It is also forbidden to ask for autographs.
- 8.) Accredited persons may not bet (or similar) and pass on any game data, if it is not required in connection with the activity at the tournament.
- 9.) Accredited persons have to inform themselves about the emergency procedures and to follow them.
- 10.) The accreditation may only be used if access to this area for the exercise of approved activities is required. Other businesses than those approved by the organizer may not be exercised with the aid of accreditation.
- 11.) The organizer may vary these terms and conditions if required for security or other legitimate interests. By signing this form it is also confirmed that third party accreditation is requested only for well-known and personal guests. It must be ensured that these persons comply with the above mentioned conduct regulations.
- 12.) For the data protection the data protection information acc. Art. 13, 14 GDPR (Appendix 1) and the declaration of consent acc. Art. 6 (1) (a) and Art. 9 (2) (a) GDPR (Appendix 2) must be observed.
